Academic Assistance	"Coffee hour" to train parents to support kids on math homework	Weekly after-school math program for case managed students below grade level	One-on-one math tutoring for a case managed student
Basic Needs/Resources	Universal breakfast program in conjunction with local food bank	Weekend backpack program for case managed students with hunger	Connect a case managed student's food-fragile family with ongoing food bank program
Behavior Intervention/ Modification	Develop a Positive Behavior Intervention and Support (PBIS) program for the school to combat bullying	Bi-weekly anti-bullying peer groups for case managed girls	Connect a case managed student who bullies with a behavior modification specialist
College Preparation	Arrange visits to local campuses, available to any student who signs up	Arrange quarterly visits to local campuses, available to targeted case managed students	Assist a case managed student with college applications and the FAFSA
Career Preparation	12th grade job fair	Ongoing career training program for case managed students with similar career goals	Connect a case managed student with job shadowing in field of interest
Community Service/Service Learning	Park clean-up day with participation based on attendance	Peer mentor program linking students from past/current caseload to new students	Arrange volunteer opportunity at nursing home for case managed student interested in nursing
Enrichment/ Motivation	Year-long '7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens' program including all-school assemblies and classroom interactions	Group study program for case managed students leading up to mid-term and final exams	Connect a case managed student with mentor to help improve study habits and test-taking skills
Family Engagement	Back-to-school family dinner for all new students	Monthly family reading night for case managed students reading below grade level	Incentive program to encourage a case managed student's family to attend school events
Life/Social Skills	Implement Incredible Years program, including "Dina Dinosaur" curriculum, for K- 2nd grade students and their parents	Implement Incredible Years small group pull-out sessions for case managed K-2nd grade students demonstrating negative behaviors	Connect a case managed student suffering from anxiety with a Coping Cat program provider
Physical Fitness/Health	Field day	Running group for case managed girls	Connect a case managed student with fitness goals to a personal trainer
Professional Mental Health	Schoolwide suicide prevention program	Counselor-facilitated groups on mental health topics for targeted case managed students	Connect a case managed student to a licensed counselor for ongoing, individual sessions
