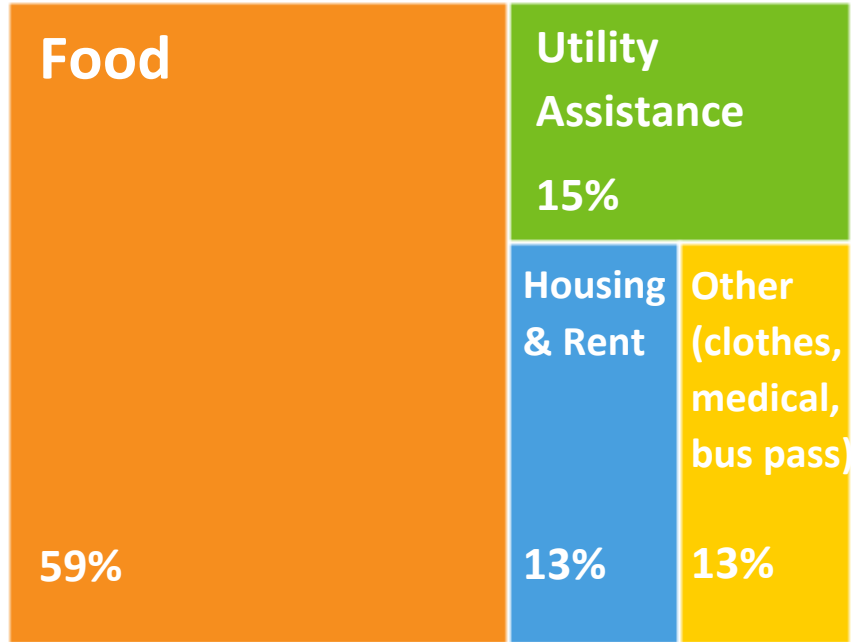

Identified Needs of CIS Families



On Monday, February 15th, Central Texas was struck with one of the worst winter storms in recorded history. On Thursday, even while facing their own personal challenges related to the storm, CIS staff began recovery efforts. Phone calls and texts to our families uncovered urgent needs such as food, water, temporary housing, and replacement of destroyed items like clothing and mattresses. Gifts cards were delivered within 24 hours of the need being identified. In addition to direct financial assistance, CIS provided:

- Diapers/Formula
- Feminine hygiene products
- Non-perishable food items
- Household items
- Community resources
- FEMA Information

Staff continue to provide emotional support and referrals to local community resources.
